The meeting of the City of Belleville Council was held on Monday, August 10, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the City of Belleville Council Meeting Room. The Governing Body met at 6:00 p.m. for a planning meeting to tour the new hanger at the airport and then return to City Hall and discussed nuisance items and the recreation program.

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor James Doyle called the Council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Rick Snodgrass offered the opening prayer and comments. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

ATTENDANCE:

Council members present: Andrew Bates, Dianne Kramer, Doane Sells, Will Boman, Mike Palmquist and Diane Boman.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES AND DISBURSEMENTS:

Will Boman made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 27th, 2026, Council Meeting. Mike Palmquist seconded the motion, which carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Diane Boman made a motion to approve the bills and their disbursements. Mike Palmquist seconded the motion, which carried unanimously on a voice vote.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Pam McGregor shared her concerns about installing a plaque for the car show on the band shell.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mike Palmquist made a motion to approve the 2027 budget as printed in the newspaper. Will Boman seconded the motion, which carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Mike Palmquist made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-022, declaring the property at 1606 N Street a nuisance. Diane Boman seconded the motion, which carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Mike Palmquist made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-023, setting a public hearing for an unfit structure at 1606 N Street. Andrew Bates seconded the motion, which carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Mike Palmquist made the motion to approve Ordinance No. 1092, authorizing the removal of an unsafe structure at 1602 N Street. Will Boman seconded the motion, which passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Mike Palmquist made the motion to approve Ordinance No. 1093, authorizing the removal of an unsafe structure at 720 M Street. Will Boman seconded the motion, which passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Diane Boman made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 1094, annexing a parcel of land along S Street into the Belleville city limits. Will Boman seconded the motion, which carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

Mike Palmquist made a motion to approve a six-month agreement with Republic County Solid Waste for monthly solid waste fees. Will Boman seconded the motion, which carried unanimously on voice vote.

CITY CLERK'S REPORT:

Council pictures will be taken prior to the August 24th meeting.

CITY MANAGER'S REPORT:

A request was shared to have a courtesy car at the airport for pilots to use. Council will discuss more at a future meeting.

COUNCIL MEMBER/MAYOR COMMENTS:

Andrew Bates thanked the Police Department for the extra shifts they worked during the fair. He also thanked Pam for attending the meeting.

Diane Boman reminded everyone that school starts this week and watch for children crossing the street.

Mayor Doyle commented on the success of the fair and races this year.
