

ORDINANCE NO. 1002

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, KANSAS:


Section 1. Pursuant to Section 2.04.090 of Belleville Municipal Code and K.S.A. 14-201 compensation for the following job classifications and pay grades are established for each full time employee of the City:


