

ORDINANCE NO. 1051

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO WATER RATES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1031 AND SECTION 13.12.110 OF BELLEVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, KANSAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the following tariff of monthly water rates for all consumption and use of water for all services excluding church properties as defined in Section 2. from the municipal water system of said City is hereby established and fixed and shall apply to and govern the water bill payable after November 1, 2022, and remain in effect thereafter until changed:

Section 2. DEFINITION. The term Church Property, as used in this ordinance, means property used for religious worship and instruction. Separate services and meters used for lawn or yard irrigation on church properties will be billed as outlined in section 1 of said ordinance.

Section 3. That the following tariff of monthly water rates for all consumption and use of water on church property from the municipal water system of said City is hereby established and fixed and shall apply to and govern the water bill payable after November 1, 2022, and remain in effect thereafter until changed:

5,001 to 1,000,000 gallons:	\$3.269
1,000,001 to 3,000,000	\$3.044
over 3,000,000 gallons:	\$2.820

Section 4. That Ordinance No. 1020, Section 13.12.110 of Belleville Municipal Code, and all subsequent amendments thereof, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from November 1, 2022, and after its publication.
