

ORDINANCE NO. 1066

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE KS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO.1057.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BELLEVILLE, KANSAS:

Section 1. The following job classifications and pay grades are established for the full-time employees of the City:

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 2.04.090 of Belleville Municipal Code and K.S.A. 14-201, the following compensation has been established for the Governing Body and is paid annually: Mayor \$1,800, City Council Member \$1,200.

Section 3. The Municipal Judge and City Attorney are contract positions. Compensation for these officers shall be fixed by resolution.

Section 4. The City Manager will establish the rate of pay for part-time or seasonal positions.

Section 5. That Ordinance No. 1057 is hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
