New and returning applicants need to complete this form entirely. Your qualifications from the application along with your answers to this questionnaire will be used to determine who will be considered for this job.

Age and Certification Requirements: Applicants must be 16 years old by May 1 of the current pool season. All guards must be Red Cross Certified before being put on the schedule. This involves passing a 30-hour Red Cross Certification Lifeguard Course taught in May and paid for by the City of Belleville. Lifeguarding at the pool is a part-time position, usually 20-24 hours per week. Upon hiring, all guards will be issued a uniform, consisting of a suit, t-shirt, jacket and fanny pack. All items except the suit will be returned at the end of the season.

IMPORTANT: All applicants, new and returning, need to answer the following questions:

1. Time off is highly considered in the hiring process. More than one week off for an aquatic position may reduce the chance of employment for new or returning applicants. Below, please write down all of the times, days and dates that you will not be available to work this summer (including college classes, other jobs, vacations, sport camps, practices, etc.). If you are unaware of your potential work conflicts please put the approximate dates/times. Failure to announce potential work conflicts now could result in termination if hired. All guards are required to be available for Red Cross Swimming Lessons.
